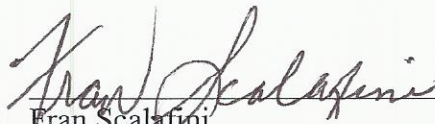
Jim Hagerty, 23W671 Walnut St., Roselle, IL 60172, discussion of IMRF retirement pension benefits in regard to previous Supervisors.

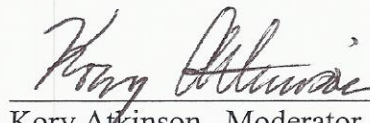
Pete Null, 453 Belden, Glendale Heights, IL 60139. Discussion of transparency, financial planning report, hiring practices, job openings and contract bidding.
