### **HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT REPORT:**

Highway Commissioner Czernek reported that construction season is now over. They have replaced a total of 100 culvert pipes and fixed drainage issues.

They have completed paving streets that were scheduled to be paved. He commented that he is testing out a compound that is thicker than seal coating and is good for "poor" condition streets. Bob explained that this product can extend the life of a road for five years and is very economical. They are testing the process on two streets to see how it works.

Brush pick up has ended for the year. He has had many problems with homeowners not following the guidelines. In addition to the very specific mailing sent out to all homeowners, Bob is planning on attending home owner association meetings before the next brush pick up season starts to stress the importance of homeowners following the guidelines.

A rather urgent issue came up in Medinah. A 30 foot deep storm sewer developed sink holes around it. This storm sewer is approximately 30 years old. The Highway Commissioner was able to contact Public Works at DuPage County and they sent out a special crew that was able to video tape inside the sewer pipe. The Highway Department is going to be able to work together with DuPage County to fix the problem before the cold weather arrives and they have secured the sink hole areas.

Electronic recycling was held on Saturday, October 3, 2015 in partnership with Bloomingdale Bank & Trust for shredding of paper. They took in 86,000 pounds of recycling. Bob thinks he is very close to the limit allowed on his contract, he may have to cover the overage costs out of his budget.

## **HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT REPORT: (Continued)**

The Highway Department should be receiving part of their salt order the last week of October. They will also be making 6,000 gallons of salt brine in house. All the plows will go on the trucks November 1<sup>st</sup>.
