Emailed or faxed proposals will not be accepted. All proposals received will be publicly opened and read at 10:00 a.m. on Friday October 25, 2019 at Bloomingdale Township, 123 N. Rosedale Avenue, Lower Level Board Room, Bloomingdale, IL 60108.

Bloomingdale Township reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive technicalities and irregularities in the bidding procedure, to accept only portions of a proposal and reject the remainder without disclosure for any reason, and to accept the bid that, in its opinion and discretion, will serve its best interest.

This is an Illinois Prevailing Wage Project. The work under the Contract is "public works" as defined by the Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/0.01 *et seq.* (the "Act"). The Contractor shall be required to pay not less than the prevailing rate of wages, as determined by the Owner and as may be amended from time to time, to all laborers, mechanics and other workers and shall comply with all other requirements of the Act. The prevailing rates of wages are revised periodically by the Department of Labor and are available on the Department's official website

All proposals must be accompanied by a bid bond or bank cashier's check payable to Bloomingdale Township for ten percent (10%) of the amount of the bid as provided in the Instructions to Bidders. No proposals or bids will be considered unless accompanied by such bond or check.

Bids shall not include federal excise tax or state sales tax for materials and equipment to be incorporated in, or fully consumed in the performance of, the Work. An Exemption Certificate will be furnished by the Owner on request of the Bidder, for use in connection with this Project only.
