The primary purpose of the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program is to assist eligible households by offsetting the rising cost of home energy through direct financial assistance.



LIHEAP - LOW INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

APPLICATION DATES AND DEADLINES

October 2, 2023 - August 15, 2024

<u>October 2</u> - LIHEAP will begin accepting applications for Seniors, Disabled and Families with Children Under 6.

November 1 - Disconnected households or households in danger of disconnection.

<u>December 1</u> - All eligible applicants.

- Eligible households are determined by household size, gross household income, geographical location, and type of energy source used.
- An overdue bill or disconnect notice is not required.
- You do not have to own your home or pay your gas and/or electric bills directly to be eligible for assistance.

THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION IS REQUIRED TO APPLY:

- Proof of gross income for all household members for the 30 days prior to and including the date you apply
- Your most recent heat and/or electric bill(s)
- Social Security card / ITIN for all household members
- · If you rent, your lease
- Additional documentation may be required
