The Highway Department continues to work on drainage issues and replacing driveway culverts. The department recently replaced an old rusty culvert under Swift Road and north of Lake Street. Highway Staff has been mowing right of ways and cutting several weed violations.

The paving program should wrap up in the next week or two. Director Nogan has met with the DuPage County Permit Department to discuss the permit required for replacing the culverts under Maple Avenue in Medinah. This project will need approval from the Army Corps of Engineers which might delay the start and completion of said project before winter sets in. Director Nogan was able to submit a request to DuPage County Stormwater for funds to help cover the cost of this project.

Director Nogan is also working with Lindco Equipment Sales in designing a new 6-wheel plow truck and trying to replace several pick-up trucks. Last electronic recycling event is on October 1, 2022 and the last brush pick up is October 24, 2022.
