NAMI- DuPage- Geri K.

Requesting \$41,900 for their program costs and staff salaries to educate students in schools from grades 5-12 and continue to run the program "Ending the Silence" that shows youth how to recognize the early warning signs of mental health.

• Northeast DuPage Family Youth Services NDFYS – Shannon H.

Requesting \$82,000 to fund continuation of 2 staff positions to help with Spanish speaking clients, individual case load groups and continue to work together with the police department.

• Ray Graham – Barb C.

Requesting \$60,000 to fund 3 parent sessions for middle school and 1 parent session for high school in addition to additional job exploration and community outreach for students.

• Teen Parent Connection- Heather

Requesting \$35,000 to help support the program "Pathway to Prevention" to understand and take charge of reproductive health.

Village of Roselle- Chief Barreto

Requesting \$202,000 to support the salaries of 2 FT Clinicians and software to support. The clinicians help respond to calls that are mental health focused and program development with all departments.

Youth Services Bureau Bloomingdale Township- Dawn A.

Requesting \$181,900 to help support salaries of 2 FT clinicians that support schools and teach "Signs of Suicide" in high school

Youth Services Bureau Childrens Network- Brenda H.

Requesting \$24,000 to fund a new computer system and professional development to increase skills on how to engage clients with connection services.

YWCA- Katie G. and Kathryn L.

Requesting \$100,000 to support continued funding for new PT mental health specialist to help with home visits from birth to 17 years. They will provide support and connect caregivers.
